The foregoing indemnification shall not apply to the extent that such indemnity is void or otherwise unenforceable under applicable law in effect on or validly retroactive to the date of this Agreement, or the date of the claim, and shall not apply where such Claims are the result of the sole negligence or willful misconduct of Lafarge. It is intended that the foregoing indemnity shall be broad and comprehensive. This indemnity shall survive the expiration or other termination of this Agreement. This indemnity is for the sole benefit of Lafarge and not for the benefit of any third party.
